Independent and User-Friendly

Students enjoy the friendly feel of the CPAA- they like the characters and sounds, the engaging graphics and the challenge of independently picking and clicking on their answers. A teacher can choose to assess one student, or use a computer lab to assess an entire class. Pre-k and kindergarten students usually finish in 10 -15 minutes; 1st and 2nd graders require 20-30 minutes. The assessment can be stopped at any point, and the child may continue from that point when testing resumes.

Information-Rich Reports

At the conclusion of the assessment, teachers may view or print a summary of class and student performance.

Interactive Graphical Reports summarize the performance of a class, school, or district. A click on a single skill brings up a grouping of students by their performance level.

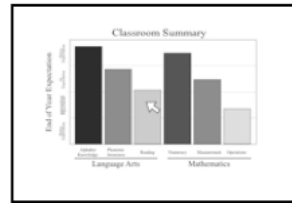
Another click brings a student's individual **Narrative Report**, which identifies the child's specific strengths and weaknesses in detail.

A teacher can use **Recommended Activities** to help a child overcome difficulties or to challenge children who have mastered a particular concept.

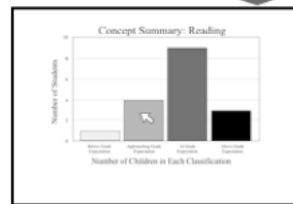
Who are we?
