



Q. Who uses nFORM?

A. nFORM is used by teachers in the classroom as a means of a formative tool.

Q. What levels are offered?

A. nFORM mini-tests are available in 6 grade level bands:

Levels 1-2	Levels 2-3	Levels 3-4
Levels 4-6	Levels 6-8	Levels 8-12

Q. What titles/subtests are included?

A. The following subtests are included:

Q. Who orders/purchases nFORM?

A. The school purchasing coordinator or any other person designated by the school can order nFORM.

Q. How do schools purchase nFORM?

A. nFORM can be purchased from ERB's shopping cart.

Q. What is the price of nFORM?

A. The price for nFORM is \$9.95 per student.

Q. Is there a minimum purchase requirement?

A. During the trial period (December 12th, 2016 – June 30th, 2017) there will be no minimum order quantity required. Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year there will be a minimum purchase requirement of 25 licenses.

Q. How long does an nForm license last?

A. nFORM student licenses are purchased on an annual basis and expire on June 30th of each year.

Q. Can a school purchase nFORM for only certain classes or grades?

A. Yes, a school can purchase nForm for a classroom, a grade, or for the whole school.

Q. Who is the user?

A. The user is the classroom teacher who assigns the quizzes for her/his students

Q. How does a teacher use nFORM?

A. Teachers can administer the pre-assembled mini-quizzes at an appropriate time, either right before or after a specific content strand/area is covered, or at any time when such a formative assessment might support instruction. After the March 2017 enhancements, teachers can assemble and administer customized quizzes.

Q. How do teachers access the nFORM portal?

A. When a school purchases nFORM a welcome email with access information is sent to the teacher/purchasing coordinator for nForm with information about accessing the portal.

Q. Can a teacher assemble quizzes?

A. Teachers will be able to assemble quizzes after enhancements to the system are made in March 2017.

Q. Can a teacher print questions?

A. There is no print capability for multiple-choice quizzes. Teachers can print PDF's of the constructed response section and administer them as in class assignments. These will be scored by the teacher and there will be no data gathered in the system.

Q. How does a teacher administer the pre-assembled quizzes?

A. Please refer to the User's Manual for specific administration instructions.

Q. What reports are available?

A. Student reports and teacher reports will be available for the 2017-2018 school year. There is a student report and a teacher class report available. The student report is for each quiz taken by the student. The class report provides information on class performance.

Q. Is historical student performance data available?

A. Yes, historical student performance data is captured and available in the student history tab.
